Edition Radical Remix by Adrian Sherwood with a 7" version of '(Set Me Free) Remotivate Me' and another remix of 'People are People' on the back; this is aswell as the normal 12" versions of 'Master and Servant' c/w '(Set Me Free)Remotivate Me' also available. September 24th sees the release of 'Some Great Reward', the new album written by Martin, with the exception of one track by Alan.

Television There could possibly be an appearance by Alan on the new series of 'Pop Quiz', apart from that no definite tv shows have been arranged.

Interviews Record Mirror Melody Maker No 1 all plan to have interviews featured.
