Hello!



After recording the TV Show we all went out with some of the other bands involved, including Curiosity Killed the Cat, The Alarm and The Mission. There was a good atmosphere between all the bands, and some started jamming up on the club's stage. Most of the songs were standard 'bluesy' numbers which got a bit boring, but The Mission saved the evening by doing some brilliant Gary Glitter covers, only stopping when Wayne Hussey was thrown offstage by the Club Manageress for 'misbehaving' onstage!

FRIDAY 23RD FEBRUARY SAN REMO:

This was a press day and it started well - Alan ran out of underwear, so I was sent out to buy some! The rest of the day was spent on the beach and (for the band) doing interviews.

That night (in the same club as the night before) Fish (ex-Marillion) got up on stage and 'did his thing' after first announcing that he used to be in Genesis (?!) and liberally distributing Tequila in preparation for his set!

SATURDAY 24TH FEBRUARY SAN REMO:

By this time we were all getting pretty tired. The band members did (yet) more interviews and we all met up with French band 'Les Negresses Vertes' for a meal. Depeche performed 'ENJOY THE SILENCE' (again) for the TV Show.

Back in the club that night, a group called 'Vitamin Z' got up to jam and failed miserably to entertain us. They were given the thumbs down and stormed off! The DJ played the 'Pump Mix' of 'PERSONAL JESUS' and the evening ended with people dancing on tables!

This day was very quiet. There wasn't much happening in the way of conversation!!

WEDNESDAY 28TH FEBRUARY PARIS:

After Fletch had recorded TVAM in the morning, we all went to Paris for a TV show called 'Surprise Surprise' (not the one with Cilla Black!) DM performed 'ENJOY THE SILENCE'. We had a Lebanese meal - mixed reactions to that one. I certainly didn't like it! There was no clubbing that evening - it was an early night for us!

THURSDAY 1ST MARCH MADRID:

Dave and Alan went to a local Radio Station to be interviewed. When they came out to the car afterwards they were chased by about 500 fans! The driver turned down what he thought was a short cut - only to find the road blocked by a skip lorry! The car was surrounded by fans going mental and Dave said afterwards that it was "pretty scary". Ingo, the security man, got out of the car and started yelling at people until they ran off.

Depeche did a TV Show called 'ROCK 'O' POP' that evening and performed 'ENJOY THE SILENCE' and 'PERSONAL JESUS'. The audience seemed to be entirely made up of DM fans, who sang along and generally went crazy! We finished up in an Italian Restaurant and then a club.

FRIDAY 2ND MARCH MADRID:


Another fairly quiet morning . Before leaving for the airport, Depeche Mode were presented with a Gold Disc for '101' .

SNIPPETS

The next single from 'VIOLATOR' is 'POLICY OF TRUTH' and will be released on April 30th. The 7" 'B' side is called 'KALEID'. There will only be 5 formats of the single released in total, due to a new BPI rule. At the time of going to press, no details were available on the other formats.

'ENJOY THE SILENCE' entered the UK Gallup chart at no.17! and Independent Radio's Network chart at 25. The video was shown on ITV's 'Chart Show' on February 10th and on BBC's 'Top Of The Pops' on February 15th. Since then, ITV's 'Motormouth' and the BBC's 'Going Live' have also played the video. The chart show have featured it almost every week since it's release! 'ENJOY THE SILENCE' went up to number 6 in the Gallup chart, where it stayed for three weeks. Unfortunately, a non-mover doesn't warrant a 'Top Of The Pops' appearance and the next week the single went down to 12 and then 20 the following week. The highest chart positions for 'ENJOY THE SILENCE' at the time of going to press were: Austria - 13, Belgium - 24, Denmark - 1!!, Finland - 2, France - 21, Germany - 2, Greece - 4, Holland - 11, Iceland - 9, Ireland - 3, Italy - 4, Norway - 4, Spain - 1!!, Sweden - 4 and Switzerland - 2.

DM have made several TV appearances in Europe to promote the single, including Spain's 'Rock 'O' Pop', recorded on the 1st March . Dave was featured on Radio 1's 'Singled Out' on 9th February and Fletch was on TVAM's 'Good Morning Britain' on February 28th



WDRE, the Long-Island based radio station who, as you know, ran the competition to find the 101 'bus' members, have released their top 200 tracks of the eighties, based on the number of WDRE airplays. DM did incredibly well being featured at nos 3 - JUST CAN'T GET ENOUGH, 14 - PEOPLE ARE PEOPLE, 23 - ROUTE 66, 37 - BLASPHE-MOUS RUMOURS, 46 - STRANGELOVE, 58 - EVERY-THING COUNTS, 118 - MASTER & SERVANT, 159 - NEVER LET ME DOWN AGAIN, and 190 - BUT NOT TO-NIGHT. With their 9 chart places, this makes DM the third most popular band on WDRE, after U2 with 14 chart places and The Cure with 10.

What with the new 'Openness' in Eastern Europe, Mute Records have now opened an office in Czechoslovakia. For the time being, it'll be concerned solely with promoting Mute product in the East European press. Hopefully in the future, specifically when the currency regulations are relaxed, they will produce records in Prague. The office is being run by George Vatka, Manager for the band Ocean, who recently supported Erasure on their tour.

Depeche Mode have done it again! 'ENJOY THE SILENCE' was Radio 1's Simon Mayo's record of the week prior to it's release and the single also won 'Chartbusters' the following week! (This is getting to be a habit!) This time, DM were up against Paul McCartney, Lloyd Cole and Tina Turner, among others. They won with 27% of all votes phoned in! I think the time has come for Simon Mayo to be made an honourary Fanclub member!

PHEW - ROCK 'N' ROLL!

On the 20th March, DM appeared at 'Wherehouse Records' in L.A. (reportedly the biggest record shop in the world) to sign copies of 'VIOLATOR'. According to press reports, around 5,000 fans had camped outside the store for the 4 days before the event and the queue was around two miles long! On the day, approximately 20,000 people turned up and the road had to be closed off to traffic! There was a 200-strong police presence and they used helicopters, horses and riot gear to try and keep the crowd under control!!! The band had hoped to stay for a few hours to chat to fans and sign records but it was impossible! Unfortunately, after only 90 minutes, the police had to close the store because it had got to a point where the safety of the fans outside, DM and the record shop staff couldn't be assured. Depeche Mode were then escorted back to their hotel by police. A Los Angeles Police Department spokesman was quoted as saying "This is our biggest police operation since the Presidential visit". There was obviously plenty of press coverage and Channel 7 news even extended their bulletin by 25 minutes to cover the event! - Birmingham HMV was never like this!!

VIOLATOR

'VIOLATOR', the long-awaited Depeche Mode album was finally released on 19th March.

The cover, depicting a stark single rose, reflects the very direct approach DM have now taken on. Also the title - Violator, though rather tongue-in-cheek, does give a hint of a powerful album, which essentially it is. Once again, 'VIOLATOR' sounds very detached from their previous albums. It covers a wide range of moods and styles - sensitive, powerful, experimental and melodic. There's also a change in the way the sounds have been made, using more conventional instruments than in the past, although remaining mostly electronic, resulting in a very minimal effect.

'BLUE DRESS' and 'WAITING FOR THE NIGHT' are both particularly emotional, combining a mixture of gentle vocals and lyrics of a very personal nature, merging, along with the other tracks, into a highly listenable album.

'VIOLATOR' is not as layered as previous albums and has the effect of a more direct and less experimental approach. I feel that this is their most mature achievement - their best ever?

TOUR NEWS

Great news for Australian DM fans! Depeche Mode will at last be coming to Oz! Although I don't have confirmed dates as yet, the concerts should be around the end of August - early September. Japanese dates will follow sometime at the beginning of September. Obviously, fan club members will be notified of dates as soon as I have them!

I've received many letters from UK members regarding DM concerts in Europe. Tickets will be made available to members for these concerts, but if you are interested in a fanclub coach trip to Paris, hopefully I will be able to organise a trip with MGP. The price (around £90) would include your ticket to the concert, one night's accomodation in a Paris Hotel, continental breakfast, Return transport by luxury coach, cross-channel ferry sailing, free time for shopping and sightseeing and the services of an MGP courier. This is by no means a definite trip, I really need to know how many of you want to go before anything can be arranged. If you are interested please write to me as soon as possible, enclosing an SAE. Obviously, numbers will have to be restricted, so it's first come first served and only two people per booking.

The UK leg of the tour will be integrated into the European part which begins in the autumn. Rather than play smaller venues all over the country, as with the 'MUSIC FOR THE MASSES' Tour, DM are planning to play larger venues in bigger towns. Full details will be winging their way to you soon! UK fans will get priority booking through the club as soon as dates are confirmed. You'll receive a form in the post with the dates.



The tour starts on May 28th in Pensecola, Florida. No venues or dates have been confirmed yet, so all US and Canadian members will be sent full details as soon as they've been made available. 


Less than a week after it's release, 'VIOLATOR' has gone gold in France, Germany, Britain, USA, Spain and Italy!!

The 17th February issue of the NME has Depeche Mode on the cover and a full interview in the centre pages with Martin and Alan. SKY Magazine's March issue has an interview with Dave. There have also been DM covers and features in Melody Maker (March 10th) and Record Mirror (March 17th)

According to Billboard's Paul Grein, 'PERSONAL JESUS' is the first record in the US Top 40 with the word 'Jesus' in the title since 1973 when The Doobie Brothers charted with 'Jesus Is Alright'. 'PERSONAL JESUS' went gold in the US before reaching the Top 40.

Both Alan and Andy have both taken holidays since Christmas. Alan went to St Lucia and returned with an enviable tan, and Andy went Ski-ing in Austria.
